INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL EXAMINATIONS CANDIDATES

- 1. Please present yourselves at the examination hall at least 30 minutes before the examination which you are sitting is due to commence.
- 2. All candidates will be required to show the Invigilators their <u>current official IBAS cards</u>. If this identification is not available the candidate will not be allowed to write the examination.
- 3. All candidates will be required to have their examination confirmation slips with them.
- 4. Candidates may only take writing utensils, e.g. pens, pencils, rulers and rubbers in a <u>clear plastic</u> container and <u>a non-programmable</u> calculator (cell phones are not permitted for this purpose) to their desks. Unmarked specified texts for open book examinations are also allowed where applicable.
